

What is Extended Services?

In 2005 the DfES set out a core offer of Extended Services which it expects all children and families will be able to access at or through their local school by 2010. This is a 0-19 agenda so activities and support for 0-4s and post 16 students are also included.

The 5 services are:

1. High quality 8am-6pm childcare provided, or signposted to, on the school-site or through other local providers. The costs vary according to the type of provision. This is all year round provision and can include Breakfast, Afterschool and Holiday clubs and childminding services.
2. A varied menu of activities, including study support – such as homework clubs, sports, music, tuition, arts and crafts, visits to museums, business and enterprise activities.
3. Parenting support – including courses, information sessions and family learning activities.
4. Community access. This includes access to adult learning programmes.
5. Swift and easy access to a wide range of specialist support services. Where children have additional unmet needs the school can access additional support.

Schools work as clusters to meet this core offer agenda. Your school is in the FLEX cluster which incorporates the following schools:

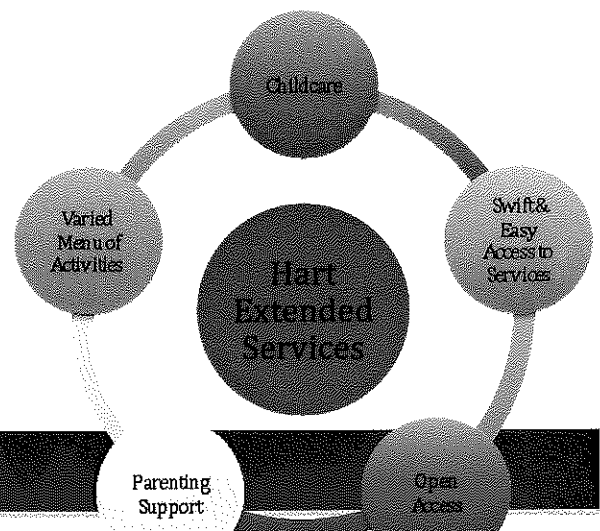

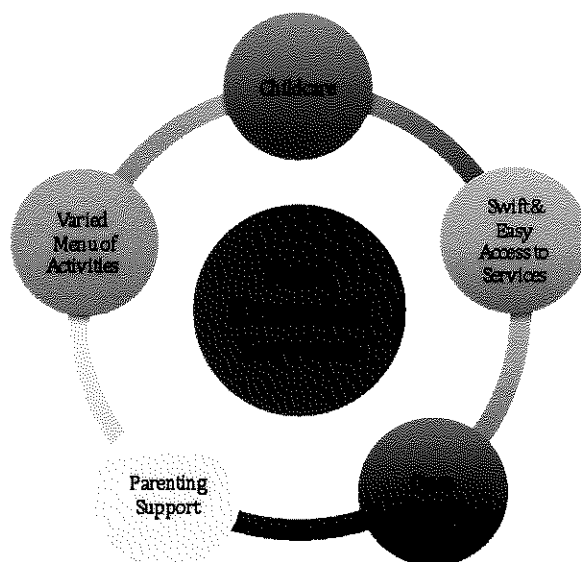

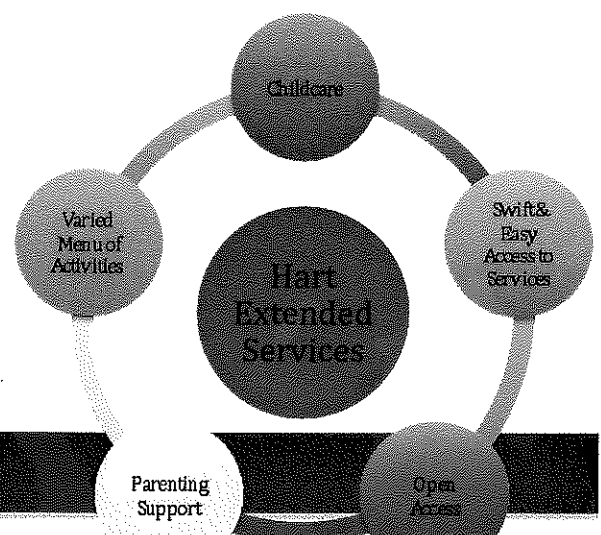

Contacting organisations

When contacting organizations you may find it useful to talk to other people who use the facility and ask specific questions of the provider eg.

- Do all persons working with the organization have CRB clearance?
- What is the level of public liability insurance cover?
- Does the organization have policies on 'safeguarding Children', 'Health & Safety' and 'Accident Procedures'?
- What are the qualifications of the instructors and are these nationally recognized?
- What is the procedure if a child becomes ill or has an accident during the session?
- If transport is involved, do all drivers have relevant qualifications and insurance cover?
